Project Summary

The Eastern Streams Community Early Childhood Council, representing Letcher, Knott, Leslie, and Perry Counties, will focus on creating awareness and providing trainings, educational tools, and information geared toward improving school readiness domain scores in cognitive and general knowledge. ESCECC will build capacity in each county by engaging stakeholders with easily understandable data and information, and by offering parent and provider trainings in conjunction with local library Literacy Days, Back to School Bashes, Grandparents Raising Grandchildren celebration day and other community events, offering mini grants, and developing a science event in conjunction with the Challenger Learning Center.

Summary of Previous Activities

Prior Activities – Perry Leslie Letcher Knott Community Early Childhood Council

The Perry Leslie Letcher Knott CECC followed a detailed work plan during the 2013-14 year to renew and re-energize the newly combined four county council around providing every child with quality early childhood experiences. The Council's staff person provided structure, assistance, and support for the group's activities and presence in the four counties.

As the joint Council developed over the past year, it chose a new name, Eastern Streams (ESCECC), and developed a face book page and twitter account. Council members appeared on radio and public access television statements to discuss the council and the importance of school readiness. Council members attended civic organization meetings and School Board Meetings.

The Council participated in a minimum of four community partner events in each county where they gave out brochures and other informational material on school readiness. These events included Back-to-School Bashes, Community Baby Showers, and civic organization events.

The Council participated in parent trainings on school readiness in each of the four counties and plans to expand parent trainings next year.

Mini-grants were awarded to those programs whose proposals clearly demonstrated the requested resources would be utilized to improve Stars Ratings and to improve the quality of the classroom environment. The council committee members vetted each proposal along with the most recent Early Childhood Environment Rating Scale/Infant/Toddler Environment Rating Scale (ECERS/ITERS) through the UK Quality Enhancement Initiative. In addition, mini-grant funding was used to provide combined training for pre-K teachers, Head Start and childcare providers.

The ESCECC hosted the first ever regional Early Childhood Education Conference with over seventy- five in attendance. The credentialed presenters were well rated in the evaluations and the Council plans to continue the conference.

The Council worked in the communities to promote the importance of aligning curriculum and collaboration among providers. Preschool curriculum is not aligned with Kindergarten readiness standards. Head Start now has classrooms in a day care center and in several school systems across the counties. This collaboration has resulted in fewer children being on school buses for longer times.

The Council's increased capacity allowed them to work with more agencies to create awareness and to work with new community partners collaboratively on future projects.

As a result of the newly combined Council, members learned that they were able to accomplish more with a broader geographical collaborative effort, but more partners are needed to have a stronger impact with more events and stakeholders.

Community Needs

The Leslie, Knott, Letcher, Perry four county region covers 1,435 square miles of rural mountain terrain in the heart of the southeastern Kentucky coal fields. The total population in the counties is 80,098, with Perry County being the biggest at 28,712.¹ Median household income ranges from \$26,857 to \$31,564 across the four counties with official child poverty rates of between 31.1% and 37.9%.² The 2014 Early Childhood Profile indicates 44-65% of the children in the four counties are living below 200% of the federal poverty level. Overall, our CECC region is a remote, rural, high poverty region with great need and lots of opportunities to improve our early care and education systems by working together.

Education attainment levels, according to the 2010 Census reports emphasize the lack of education and its impact on the area. Leslie County reported 22.5% of the population with less than a 9th grade education and only 4.1% of the entire population has a bachelor's degree or higher. Knott County reported 21.2% of the population with less than a 9th grade education and only 6.7% of the entire population has a bachelor's degree or higher. Letcher County reported 14.7% of the population with less than a 9th grade education and only 5.8% of the entire population has a bachelor's degree or higher. Perry County reported 15.6% of the population with less than a 9th grade education and only 6.7% of the entire population has a bachelor's degree or higher. These figures compare to Kentucky as a whole having 7.9% of the population having lower than a 9th grade education and 12.3% of the state having a bachelor's degree or higher. The low levels of educational attainment translate to families not valuing education and this indicates that school readiness is not a high priority in these counties.

The 2014 Early Childhood Profiles from the Governor’s Office of Early Childhood provide the Council with a good base of knowledge to create a comprehensive, targeted plan for improving kindergarten readiness and child outcomes across our region. According to these reports, there are 4,982 children under the age of 5 in our CECC region³. Indicators of child well-being for all counties include increasing numbers of early childhood obesity, low rates of pre-natal care and rising numbers of substantiated child abuse.⁴ More than 75% of all children in the four counties receive some form of public assistance. In 2014, 3,179 children were living at 200 % below the poverty level, with the highest concentration being in Perry County with 1,254 children.⁵ Currently, 567 children ages 3 to 4 at 150% of the poverty level are enrolled in Head Start and 471 are enrolled in public preschool programs across the four counties. With approximately 75% of our children receiving some form of public assistance, and approximately one-third living in poverty, the ESCECC estimate as many as 2,339 children under the age of five that are currently not receiving any form of early childhood education services that could benefit with appropriate outreach and supports from a coordinated early childhood education system.



The 2014 Early Childhood profiles also show that the most prevalent commonality in each of the four counties is the lack of cognitive/general knowledge in relationship to the state and physical well-being is also an area that indicates serious attention in three of the four counties. Thus, our CECC will direct the majority of the activities toward improving the cognitive/general knowledge domain and the physical well-being domain as we increase awareness and educational opportunities to prepare our families and children for kindergarten readiness. The ESCECC will provide educational materials and increase outreach activities to strengthen families' abilities in both of these domains, cognitive/general and physical well-being to assist with school readiness in all four communities in our region.



Perry County is typically considered a hub for the eight counties in the Kentucky River Area Development District, which includes Leslie, Letcher, Knott, and Perry counties. Many people from surrounding counties come to work, shop, and receive services such as healthcare and childcare in Hazard, the county seat of Perry County. According to the Governor's Office of

Early Childhood profiles, most childcare services and opportunities are in Perry County. Hazard Community & Technical College (HCTC), located in Perry County with extension campuses in Leslie and Knott Counties, offers an Associate of Applied Science degree in Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education with multiple certificate milestones for providers, assistants, administrators, and teachers. Southeast Kentucky Community and Technical College has a local campus in Letcher County, which offers some local training opportunities and two-year degree opportunities. The East Kentucky Child Care Coalition and the University of Kentucky Quality Enhancement Initiative also offer training across the region, making it possible for early childhood educators to obtain any level of training desired, from a Commonwealth Credential to an Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education Birth to Primary Teacher. Availability of training is not a barrier for our counties, rather costs, time, transportation and other resources are. The desire to attend continuing education is also lacking, particularly when there is no indication that more education will lead to higher wages. Our CECC will work to reduce the barriers to training and increase the access to high quality training for all early childhood providers in our region.

Kentucky's clear definition of kindergarten readiness and universal use of the kindergarten readiness screener supports the need for curriculum adjustment and alignment across early childhood education programs. LKLP Head Start has implemented a new and improved curriculum and is working with the public school systems and childcare to develop and promote the incorporation of newly aligned standards across all programs to ensure kindergarten readiness. One of the most prevalent issues regarding this level of collaboration between Head Start, Preschool and childcare is the attainment of a 3 or 4 star rating in the STARS quality rating system. Of the thirty child care providers in the four county region, 23 are participating in the

STARS quality rating system, however 17 of those are licensed Head Start facilities. According to the UK QEI outreach staff, most of those are not interested in participating because they see no benefit, the cost is prohibitive, and there is no demand from parents. Clearly, parent and provider awareness and education is needed to promote the benefits of STARS and the quality components for parents and children, as well as the support and additional tools for providers. Our CECC will continue to support UK QEI staff in building a professional network of childcare providers that understand the benefits of STARS. Our CECC will become proactive in marketing for STARS, utilizing supports from the Governor's Office of Early Childhood, existing STAR rated facilities and others.

Finally, initial data from the academic year 2013-14 year for kindergarten readiness screening indicates approximately 70% of our children in the region are not well prepared to start school. The overarching goal for our CECC will be to continue to improve this statistic over time, with immediate incremental improvements, focused in the domain of cognitive and general knowledge and physical well-being.

Strategic Plan

During Community Early Childhood Council (CECC) Project year 2013-2014, two separate CECC Councils, Knott/Letcher and Perry/Leslie were funded as combined council, hired part-time staff and became operational as one four county council. The combined Council has grown together as one entity and established itself with a new name, the Eastern Streams Community Early Childhood Council (ESCECC). The Council recognized the commonality of their endeavor and realized that by combining resources and realigning under a fiscal and managerial organization of a non-profit serving each of the four counties with childhood education programs, the Council's capacity, leverage, resources, and successes would be greatly

increased. The ESCECC has had successes, including the first four county CECC sponsored training conference, and more importantly recognized there is much more work to do to promote early childhood education and kindergarten readiness in all stakeholder groups across the counties.

The Eastern Streams CECC will continue to function independently under the auspices of LKLP Community Action Council, Inc., which has operated Head Start programs for over thirty-five years. The agency also operates a number of other state, federal, and local human service programs in each of the four counties and has the capacity to continue to offer infrastructure and staff to ensure the Council's sustainability as the coordinating entity for all early childhood initiatives in the four county service area. Thus, allowing the Council to provide more outreach, awareness, and events in each of the four counties. The Council will continue to accomplish this by again hiring a half time staff person from LKLP Head Start to integrate all suggestions of the combined councils, coordinate all trainings, execute the communication plan, collect and disseminate data, and champion the work of the Council for early childhood education and kindergarten readiness. The LKLP Staff person, who will be the Council Staff, will not be a member of the Council and have no vote. The staff person will follow all directives of the Council and be responsible for carrying out all Council assigned tasks, including participating in monthly webinar trainings hosted by the Governor's Office of Early Childhood.

The Eastern Streams CECC will accomplish the goal of creating and supporting a more integrated, higher-quality early childhood system of services by providing contracted staff to support and champion the work of the Council. The staff and agency support will provide the framework critically needed for the combined Council to strengthen and build collaborative partnerships to promote school readiness for children and families. The combined Council

proposes to continue to serve the four counties, Leslie, Knott, Letcher, and Perry in the southeastern part of the Kentucky River Area Development District. This regional Council will continue to combine, coordinate, and multiply the work of the two previous councils, Knott/Letcher and Perry/Leslie.

The CECC strategies have functioned much better with a coordinated effort to engage the community stakeholders. During the coming year, the ESCECC's work will continue to focus on establishing a more diverse regional Council within the guidelines of the KIDS Now statutes and more specifically on the need for more cognitive and general knowledge in the four counties early childhood population.

This focus will cover the key strategies of the Early Childhood Advisory Council, including (1) Supporting High Quality Learning Environments at Home and in community based settings (2) Supporting Families and (3) Providing Access to Data. These three components will be addressed with a targeted-approach to increasing awareness of the need for improvement in cognitive and general knowledge and by providing trainings, information, and tools to parents and providers to help improve these domain scores. The Council will provide trainings for parents, and providers, and mini-grants for providers to support high quality learning environments. The Council will support and strengthen families by providing information on developmental stages and tools, such as books and puzzles for cognitive and general knowledge. Parents will also be supported by community activities presented by the ESCECC or in collaboration with community partners. Parents and/or grandparents and guardians will be provided with special trainings fashioned after the borne learning academy approach. The ESCECC will provide access to clear, understandable data to the community to increase awareness and public commitment. The Council will also work with parents/guardians to help

them understand their children's screener results and what activities they can utilize to help improve the cognitive and general knowledge domain for school readiness.

Community engagement will be addressed through leveraging of funds, resources, and collaborative projects. CECC funds will be utilized to leverage additional community resources to provide strategic mini grants in the community and multi-county events that will improve quality, coordination of efforts, and awareness in all community stakeholders. The ESCECC will continue to work collaboratively to hold Literacy days in the four counties, attend back to school bashes and other community functions to provide trainings and tools to strengthen families.

The Council will also work collaboratively to integrate a robust communication plan to inform parents and the community at large about the essential components of school readiness and the resources available to ensure every child enters school ready to succeed and flourish.

The ESCECC vision for our combined communities recognizes that this is cumulative work, with opportunities for significant change through consistent collaborative effort is:

- Every child has the opportunity to attend a high quality preschool in a public or private setting
- Every parent/caregiver has access to the resources they need to thrive as a parent/educator of her/his own child
- Parents/caregivers and children are creating and engaging in active learning environments throughout the first 5 years
- Every child will have the skills/tools necessary to succeed in Kindergarten and beyond
- Our community will develop a culture where we value early childhood education

- Early childhood education will be viewed as a cost effective investment in the future of our community and our economy

During the 2014-15 year, the Eastern Streams CECC will implement a strategic plan to fulfill our vision based on the data from the county profiles in the school readiness domains and other local data. To begin to move towards our vision by addressing three specific goals determined through an evaluation of our community needs data. Specifically, the 2014-15 goals for our CECC are:

- To build effective community partnerships that ensure a dynamic infrastructure for robust early childhood education in Leslie, Knott, Letcher and Perry Counties;
- To improve early care and education, specifically targeting children who are identified as at risk and not being served by any program and children currently in child care settings who qualify for child care subsidies; and
- To raise community and family awareness of early childhood development, school readiness, and quality early childhood programs.

The Council recognizes that coordination and collaboration are critical to addressing all of these goals. LKLP will commit a .5 FTE employee to support the work of the CECC across the four county region. Having dedicated staff will provide the level of support needed to keep a large Council with multiple school districts and other providers motivated, active and on task. Currently, we have a growing listserv for our notice of meetings, dissemination of information and the coordination of CECC events. Attendance at monthly meetings is typically 25-30 people and we are working to increase that number. ESCECC meets monthly, recognizing that adjustments may need to be made to accommodate all four counties including a change of

location, time and/or multiple county subcommittees. These logistical issues are addressed at the first meeting and as needed throughout the year.

Outcomes and activities are outlined in the attached Work Plan template. Staff will support individual members and cohorts of the CECC in performing the detailed activities related to each goal. The Council begins each year by conducting a scan of all current practices and curricula in use in early childhood education programs in our region, focused particularly on public pre-K, Head Start and STAR rated child care facilities. This information is utilized as a base for ensuring alignment of the curriculum across programs. Once curricula are aligned to address kindergarten readiness, equitable collaborative agreements will continue be negotiated between pre-K, Head Start and community based childcare programs where applicable and feasible.

In order to promote increased access to quality preschool and increase collaboration, more participation in the STAR quality rating system will be required. We will engage in significant outreach to childcare professionals for inclusion in the CECC and all CECC activities through personal contact, newsletters and other media. Our plan also includes offering incentives to participate in STARS including mini-grants particularly to support additional training required, provide transportation subsidies to attend training, and curriculum enhancements. Coordinated training and events between schoolteachers, childcare providers, and Head Start professionals will also be held. The CECC will encourage coordinated trainings by offering subsidies to help pay for trainers and resources to alleviate other barriers identified.

Increasing awareness of the definition and importance of kindergarten readiness and how cognitive and general knowledge are components where our children are deficient will be the overreaching focus of the CECC in the coming year. In addition to implementation of a rigorous

communications plan, the CECC will again appoint members to participate and present to local school boards, civic clubs, Chambers of Commerce, the Area Development District, and other groups as identified throughout the year. Parents will be targeted for stronger, more meaningful participation in the CECC, for attendance at regular meetings and through CECC sponsored parent events at local early childhood program sites.

The ESCECC will target each county with \$500 allocated toward purchasing puzzles, books and other shape, color and size educational tools to be utilized at community events such as local library Literacy Days, Back to School Bashes, Grandparents raising Grandchildren celebration day, etc. These events touch on two outcomes, increasing awareness for parents and community partners of our children's need for more cognitive and general knowledge skills in the school readiness domain and then providing training to parents or guardians who bring them to this event and providing tools, such as puzzles and books, so they can replicate the trainings at home. The parents will also be given developmental information and resources on all areas of school readiness. The outcome is that awareness is increased and training or professional development for parents is provided to help them improve their children's school readiness.

The timelines for these events are different in each county. Some back to school bashes start in mid-July through the beginning of school. To ensure the ESCECC's participation in these events, the Council will have the staff person create a master calendar for the group. Volunteers from the community and Council members will work at all of these events.

The Council will work collaboratively with the Perry County Rotary Club first on the Dolly Parton Imagination Library to ensure that low-income pre-school children receive books. The Council will expand its work in this area to partner with other Rotary Clubs.

To increase community awareness of the area's deficiency in the cognitive and general knowledge domain, the Council will utilize its Communication Plan and large Training Event. The data will be provided in an easily understandable format and the group will be asked to brainstorm for possible activities to engage parents and community partners in activities and other trainings to improve this domain. The outcome will be measured in the number of people who attend.

ESCECC will continue its regional training conference in conjunction with the Prevent Child Abuse conference to reach a larger audience and to leverage resources.

The centerpiece of the event schedule for the upcoming year, is a collaboration between ESCECC and the Challenger Learning Center on the main campus of Hazard Community and Technical College. ESCECC members will work with the Challenger Team to develop a science problem solving mission for pre-school children. This is an exciting opportunity to develop a new partnership and cognitive activity involving science and math for pre-school children to help them acquire the skills needed for school readiness. The outcome will be that at-risk, low-income children will have the opportunity to participate in a science and math themed activity that will assist them in improving their cognitive and general knowledge skills. As soon as this grant is funded, ESCECC members will select a committee to work with the Challenger Center staff on this activity, which will take place by June 2015. Parent volunteers will be recruited for assistance with this project, as well as ESCECC members. The Council will work with providers to establish a time for children to attend the activity.

In summary, all ESCECC activities have measurable outcomes that increase parent and/or provider and community awareness of Screener results and the importance of cognitive and general knowledge. The majority of these activities provide direct trainings, tools, resources

and information for replication and expansion of in-home, community settings or child care settings to increase children's school readiness in this domain. Although each activity is specifically geared toward the cognitive and general knowledge domain, each will also enhance all other domains. For example, social and emotional development will be addressed through behavior in group settings. Approaches to learning will be incorporated in the training to teach parents and child care providers the different methods of learning and how to incorporate each of them to engage children in learning activities. Health and physical well-being will be incorporated as part of awareness in developmental progress, and creating stimulating learning environments. Language and communications development will be incorporated as a way parents can gauge their children's developmental progress and school readiness. Parents will be provided resources for locating any additional requested assistance for their children or additional training and training tools at all ESCECC activities.

Communications Plan

Overview

The Eastern Streams CECC (ESCECC) will continue to integrate a four county media outreach campaign utilizing print, electronic, broadcast, social media and outreach strategies. Each Council county has at least one newspaper, and either has a radio station or is reached by a neighboring radio station and a public access television channel and all are part of the viewing area of Channel 56. The ESCECC Coordinator will assist the Council with implementing the plan, including placing PSAs, printing and distributing brochures, updating web pages and social media as directed by the Council.

Print Media

Utilizing print media, the Council will continue to distribute PSAs, articles, brochures, and fliers to raise awareness and promote Kindergarten readiness. The Council will distribute informational brochures about kindergarten readiness at doctor's offices, health departments, and libraries across the four county area.

Electronic/Social Media

The Council will continue to grow its listserv or electronic distribution list to disseminate information from GOEC, ECAC and other reliable sources. The Council Chair will send a monthly eblast newsletter to the listerv featuring information from the newsletters in the Toolkit and a schedule and update of ESCECC activities. The Council will construct a web page and link with community partners. The Council also has a Wikki page .means for Council electronic communications. Additionally, the Council will continue its Face Book page and has developed a Twitter account, @easternstreams .

Broadcast Media

Utilizing broadcast media, the Council will develop PSAs for the radio stations. Three of the four counties Council members and/or the Coordinator will continue to seek an appearance on Moms Everyday on Channel 56, WYMT-TV, which reaches 49 counties, and appear on the public access television shows, Community Voice, which reaches 40 counties.

Community Events Participation

The plan also incorporates Council Outreach with Kindergarten Readiness booths in each of the four counties at festivals, Black Gold Festival (Perry), Mary Breckinridge Festival (Leslie), Mountain Heritage Festival (Letcher), and Gingerbread Festival (Knott). Booths will also be set up at March of Dimes, Relay for Life, Community Foundation Walk, Open Houses, Preschool-Kindergarten registrations, Back to school bashes, health fairs, Safe Halloween (at Armory), Public Libraries and churches. During these events, information such as flyers about ESCECC and its activities, 50 books to read before K, etc. will be distributed. The Council will use face painting, balloon animals, free cotton candy, etc. to attract parents. Parent guides will be distributed to all children/parents in all early childhood settings and council sponsored early childhood events. The Council will develop and distribute hands on activities for Preschoolers in bags to take home with prizes and coupon certificates for completing activities.

Community Civic Awareness Engagements

CECC representatives and/or the CECC Coordinator will continue to attend, network, present at Chamber of Commerce, School Board meetings, Area Development District, Civic Clubs and other community organizational meetings and events.

ESCECC will work with Public Libraries in each of the four counties to host a reading event and utilize all forms of media to advertise the event.

Regional Broadcast Opportunity

ESCECC plans to partner with the surrounding CECCs to pursue with WYMT-TV, the idea of a weekly CECC minute that would help promote kindergarten readiness and stress the importance of using daily interactions as learning opportunities. These tips would come from the Toolkit and we would link all regional CECC's web pages to the television station's website. ESCECC will spearhead this effort since the station's headquarters are located in Hazard, KY. Each CECC tip will have a tag line that says sponsored by your local CECC and refer viewers to the website for addresses and contacts. This, if possible, will require support from the Governor's Office of Early Childhood Education, such as a letter. As a part of this initiative, ESCECC also plans to offer to be on WYMT's Questions and Answers with several other regional coordinators and perhaps, Ms. Flannery.
